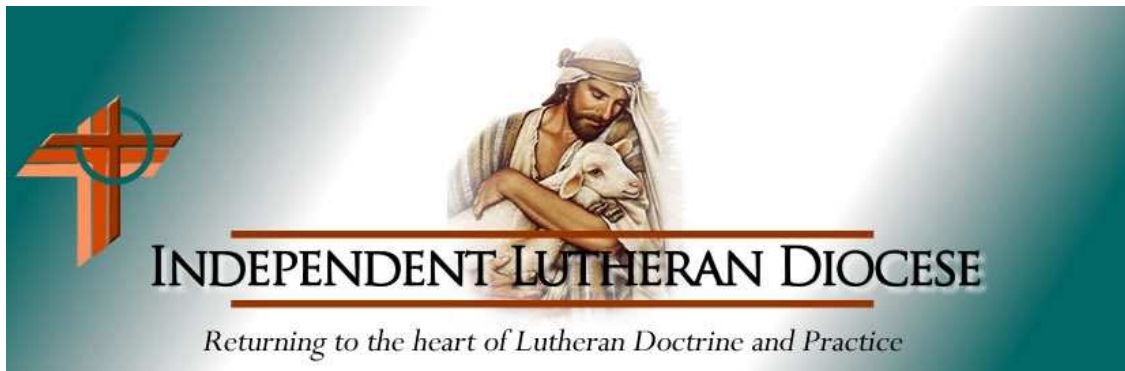

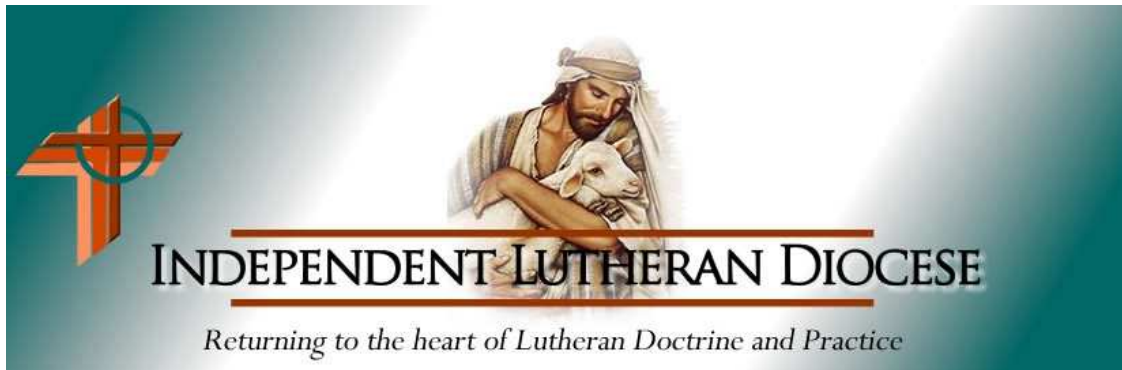

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CONSTITUTION of the INDEPENDENT LUTHERAN DIOCESE

ARTICLE 1 - Purpose

Desiring the promotion of true orthodoxy in the unity of the true faith by returning to our first love, Jesus Christ, and the Traditional Liturgy, Doctrines and faith of the Lutheran Church, this organization is formed.

ARTICLE 2 - Name

The name of this organization shall be: The Independent Lutheran Diocese (hereafter referred to as the ILD).

ARTICLE 3 - Statement of Faith

Section 1. The ILD accepts the canonical Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as the verbally inspired and inerrant Word of God, and as the only infallible rule and norm of Christian doctrine and practice.

Section 2. The ILD accepts the Symbolical Books of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, contained in the Book of Concord (1580), as true and faithful expositions of the Word of God, and as correct statements of the teaching of Holy Scripture and of the faith of the ILD. These Symbolical Writings are: The Apostles' Creed, the Nicene Creed, the Athanasian Creed, the Unaltered Augsburg Confession, the Apology of the Augsburg Confession, the Smalcald Articles, the Treatise on the Power and Primacy of the Pope, Luther's Small

Catechism, Luther's Large Catechism, and the Formula of Concord (Epitome).

Section 3. The substance of this article shall remain unalterable.

ARTICLE 4 - Duties of the ILD

- To stand guard over the purity and unity of doctrine within the ILD and to oppose false doctrine.
- To help pastors remain faithful in the performance of their duties.
- To prepare future pastors for service in the Church.
- To examine candidates for the Holy Ministry.
- To provide for ecclesiastical ordination and installation into the pastoral office.
- To assist congregations in need of pastoral care.
- To give theological opinions.
- To strive for uniformity in ceremonies.
- To maintain in the congregations the exclusive use of orthodox hymnals, agendas, and catechetical materials.
- To establish connections with Orthodox, Confessional Lutheran Churches.
- To establish mission congregations wherever the Lord provides opportunity.

ARTICLE 5 - Governance

Section 1. The initial government of this organization shall be vested in the Presiding Bishop until a Board of three (3) Trustees, which shall include the Presiding Bishop, the Secretary, and the Treasurer can be formed. The number of Trustees shall remain at three (3) until the first General Meeting of the, at which time the voting members of the organization may elect up to four (4) additional Trustees, including an Auxiliary Bishop, if there is a qualified candidate for this office among the members of the organization. The total number of Trustees shall not exceed seven (7).

Section 2. The Presiding Bishop, and Auxiliary Bishop when such vacancy exists, shall be called by the Church through the General Meeting.

Section 3. The term of office for the Secretary and the Treasurer shall be four (4) years. The term of office for other Trustees shall be two (2) years.

ARTICLE 6 - Role of Trustees

The Trustees shall have the general management and control of all the secular business and temporal affairs of said organization. All such business and affairs they shall conduct in accordance with the constitution, bylaws, rules and resolutions of the ILD. The Secretary shall keep a record of all transactions of the Board.

ARTICLE 7 - Presiding Bishop and Auxiliary Bishop

Section 1. The Presiding Bishop and Auxiliary Bishop must be ordained ministers of the ILD.

Section 2. The Presiding Bishop shall supervise the doctrine and practice of the ILD's ministers and member congregations, and he may be assisted in this regard by the Auxiliary Bishop.

Section 3. The Bishop and Auxiliary Bishop may be a pastor of a member congregation of the ILD. Each of them is subject to the same disciplinary procedures which apply to any ordained minister of the ILD.

Section 4. In the event of the resignation, incapacitating illness, or death of the Presiding Bishop, the Auxiliary Bishop (if one is called to that position) shall assume the office of Presiding Bishop until the next General Meeting of the ILD, at which time a permanent successor shall be selected by vote from the geographical Bishops of the churches of the ILD and under inspiration from God and Jesus Christ. The Presiding Bishop has to reside within the continental United States.

Section 5. The Presiding Bishop, Auxiliary Bishop, and local Bishop are perpetual terms.

ARTICLE 8 - The Treasurer

The Treasurer shall receive and disburse the funds of the organization under the direction of the ILD and its Board of Trustees. The funds of the organization shall be used in carrying out the

purposes of the organization as stated in Article 4 of this constitution and for the support and advancement of orthodox Lutheran institutions and missions which meet the criteria of Article 3 of this constitution. The Treasurer shall keep true account of all funds received and disbursed and make full report to the Board of Trustees at such times as the Board, by resolution, may request. He shall give such bond for the faithful performance of his duties as the Board may direct. The fiscal year of the ILD shall be Jan1st through Dec 31st.

ARTICLE 9 - Elected Officers

Until such a time as Trustees can be elected, The duties of the Secretary and Treasurer shall be vested in the Presiding Bishop of the Church.

ARTICLE 10 - Election of Officers

Election of officers and Trustees of this organization shall take place at its annual General Meeting. In the event of the vacancy of an office, the remaining Trustees shall appoint an eligible person to fill his office until the next regular General Meeting of the ILD, except in the vacancy of the office of the Presiding Bishop.

ARTICLE 11 – General Meetings of the ILD

The ILD shall meet in a General Meeting to conduct its affairs, at a time and place convenient to its members. The time and place of such Meeting shall be determined in consultation with the members of the organization as shall be determined by the Board of Trustees. The ILD will meet in General Meeting at least once every two years. The Trustees shall call a Meeting of the ILD upon the petition of the majority of its member congregations.

ARTICLE 12 - Determination of a Quorum

A quorum to carry on the business of this organization at any of its regular General Meetings shall be the number of voting members present.

ARTICLE 13 – Dissolution

Should dissolution be determined necessary, any ILD assets remaining after the payment of all outstanding debts shall be disposed of by transfer to one or more organizations, institutions, associations, foundations, etc. which serve one or more of the

purposes of this organization as determined by its members in a legally called meeting.

ARTICLE 14 - Concerning Articles & Bylaws

The Articles and Bylaws of this constitution may be changed or repealed, or any new ones added at any regular General Meeting the ILD by a vote of not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the voting membership present, provided that proposed changes are published in the Reports and the same sent to member congregations at least thirty (30) days prior to the first day of the general Meeting.

ARTICLE 15 - Bylaws, Amendments and Continuing Resolutions (Procedures)

Section 1. The ILD may adopt or amend bylaws of this constitution at any General Meeting of the ILD by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the voting member present. All proposed bylaw changes must be available to congregations at least thirty (30) days prior to the first day of the General Meeting.

Section 2. This constitution may be amended at any General Meeting of the ILD by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the voting members present, except for those Articles which are determined to be unalterable. All proposed amendments must be available to congregations at least six (6) months prior to the first day of the General Meeting.

Section 3. Continuing Resolutions that pertain to the administrative functions of the ILD may be adopted or amended by a majority vote of the General Meeting. Continuing Resolutions that pertain to the public confession of this ILD on matters of doctrine or morality may be adopted or amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the General Meeting.

ARTICLE 16 - Rules of Order

All official meetings of the ILD, or that of any of its Boards or committees, shall be conducted in accordance with the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE 17 – Advisory Nature of the ILD

The ILD is only advisory with respect to member congregations with their pastors. Individual congregations operate according to their own constitution and bylaws.

ARTICLE 18 - Membership

The members of the ILD are the ordained ministers and the congregations which have been received into membership according to the procedures outlined in this constitution.

ARTICLE 19 - Property Ownership

Each member congregation of the ILD will retain full title to its properties. The ILD will make no stipulations or bylaws denying the property rights of its member congregations. The ILD will afford its member congregations full freedom to separate themselves from ILD by whatever manner is stipulated in their congregational constitutions. The ILD will make no stipulation or bylaw denying member congregations freedom to leave the ILD. The constitutions of individual congregations will stipulate their own relationship with the ILD in regard to membership and property. If a congregation dissolves, its property may be given to the ILD to dispose of in the manner that congregation so desires.

ARTICLE 20 - Member Congregations

Section 1. A congregation which seeks membership in the ILD, shall adhere to the following procedure:

- a.** It shall terminate its membership in any other church-body with which it may be affiliated.
- b.** It shall profess its agreement with the doctrinal basis of the ILD as set forth in Article 3 of this constitution.
- c.** It shall be served by a pastor who holds membership in the ILD and who will conduct his ministry in its midst in accordance with the doctrine and practice of the ILD.
- d.** If necessary, it shall revise and/or amend its constitution and bylaws in order to bring them into harmony with the constitution and bylaws of the ILD.
- e.** When ready to do so, it shall formally apply for membership in the ILD by declaring that its doctrine and practice are in agreement with the doctrine and practice of the ILD, and by declaring that it will abide by the constitution and bylaws of the ILD. It must apply for

membership through the Presiding Bishop and be accepted provisionally by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees.

f. When the pastor of a member congregation believes that his congregation is in a crisis situation, he shall consult with the local Bishop who will, in turn, consult with the Board. After investigation, the Board, in consultation with the local Bishop and the pastor of the congregation will determine whether or not the congregation is, indeed, in a crisis situation. If the congregation is determined to be in crisis, the Board and the local Bishop will assume management of the congregation until such time as the situation is resolved to the satisfaction of the Board and the local Bishop.

1.) Crisis situations will include-but not be limited to-a member-or members-who cause continual dissention in the congregation to the point of creating an unstable environment; members who are under discipline but refuse to accept said discipline; situations of personal danger to the pastor and/or members of the congregation.

2.) Other situations will be determined by the individual pastor, in consultation with the local Bishop and the Board.

Section 2. A congregation which holds membership in the ILD, may send a voting delegate to the General Meeting of the ILD.

Section 3. Adjunct Congregations. When a congregation is part of another church body, that congregation may apply to become an adjunct congregation of the ILD. It must, however, adhere to the ILD constitution. When it has severed membership with its former church body, it may then apply for congregational status in the ILD.

ARTICLE 21 - Ordained Ministers

Section 1. An ordained Lutheran minister who seeks membership in the ministerium of the ILD must be in agreement with the doctrine and practice of the ILD, and he must agree to abide by the constitution and bylaws of the ILD. He must not hold simultaneous membership in any other church-body. He must apply for membership through the Presiding Bishop and be accepted provisionally by the Board of Trustees, with final acceptance by majority vote of local Bishops

Section 2. In addition to the stipulations of Section 1 of this Article, an ordained candidate for membership who is not a member of a church-body with which the ILD is in fellowship must participate in a

colloquy arranged by the Board of Trustees, in order to determine his agreement with the doctrine and practice of the ILD. Following provisional acceptance by the Board of Trustees, the candidate will be eligible to accept a call in the ILD.

Section 3. An ordained candidate for membership who is entering the ILD from another Lutheran church-body may be received by transfer into the ILD in accordance with Section 2 of this Article.

Section 4. An ordained member who is a member of the ministerium of the ILD may participate and vote in the General Meeting of the ILD.

Section 5. Ordained ministers of the ILD shall be subject to church discipline for the following reasons: a) teaching or preaching false doctrine; b) malfeasance of duty; c) immoral conduct (including, adultery, homosexuality, drunkenness, criminal behavior, etc.). Upon a charge of misconduct under one of the above categories, the Trustees of the ILD shall appoint a committee to investigate and report on the charge. If the accused is a trustee of the ILD, he shall not participate in the appointment of such a committee or the disciplinary decisions of the Board of Trustees. Discipline shall be determined and administered by the Board of Trustees and the Ministerium, in accordance with the Holy Scriptures (Matthew 18:15-19; Luke 17:3; Titus 3:10, etc.).

ARTICLE 22 - Theological Students

A theological student studying for the ministry under the auspices of the ILD may attend a theological seminary approved by the ILD. As part of his theological studies, he may serve for approximately one year as a vicar (Deacon) in a member congregation of the ILD, or, if approved by the Presiding Bishop of the ILD, may establish a congregation. Upon finishing his studies, and upon approval of the Trustees of the ILD, he will be eligible for ordination and a call to a member congregation of the ILD, or to a congregation that is in the process of becoming a member congregation of the ILD. Upon his acceptance of a call, he will be ordained by the local Bishop, or a minister of the ILD who has been authorized by the local Bishop.

- We believe, teach and accept the Unaltered Augsburg Confession and the other confessional writings in the Book of Concord (1580), as further valid expositions of the Holy Scriptures.
- We accept the Constitution of the Independent Lutheran Diocese and will conform to ILD standards.

In the conviction that God has called us through the Lordship of his Son Jesus Christ and the guidance of His Holy Spirit to teach and confess the gospel in its purity, this congregation and its Pastor(s) has voted to join the Independent Lutheran Diocese, subject to acceptance by the ILD Board of Trustees.

Upon the approval by the ILD Board of Trustees, a congregation is received as a fully rostered member to the ILD Congregational roster.

Application Steps and Procedures for Pastors and Seminarians

Step 1. The Pastor or Seminarian desirous of colloquy with the ILD to the rostered membership in ILD must complete the ILD Application for Ordination / Transfer of Credentials to the Office of the Presiding Bishop. Certain Questionnaire SETs may be required in conjunction with the application. These will be sent to the individual.

Step 2. Applicant will be contacted when the above step has been received by the Office of the Presiding Bishop and is placed in contact with the Auxiliary Bishop and local Bishop.

Step 3. Applicant may be requested to submit a criminal background check and should contact an appropriate agency of his State or Province and request a Criminal background check with the results stipulated to be sent to the Presiding Bishop.

Step 4. Applicant will be contacted by the members in step 2 for an interview.

Step 5. The interviewing members will convene to consider the request of the applicant.

Step 6. Applicant will be contacted with the results after review of the applicant's application, questionnaire SETs, and interviews have been completed and duly considered.
